WHITE & ROSE

MINUTY "M" ROSÉ

Notes of red fruit dominate the nose. The palate is greedy and round, with crunchy fruit. A slight sweetness tempers its liveliness. An introduction to the expression of Provence rosé.

Vivino: 3.9/5 | Panel Rating: 8/10

MINUTY PRESTIGE ROSÉ

The nose is very expressive, revealing floral notes that give way to aromas of apricot and yellow peach. On the palate, finesse dominates, accompanied by a subtle touch of citrus and a saline finish. Vivino: 34.0/5 | Panel Rating: 8/10

HARRY HARTMAN "CHURCH"CHENIN 2021

Investors like Harry Hartman are sourcing, in this case, Chenin Blanc from 40-year-old vines from the Swartland to be in vogue. 100% Whole-bunch pressed grapes, matured for eleven months, with higher acidity and a more rugged mouthfeel: its perfect with seafood.

LE CHANT DE COQ CHENIN

This 35 year old vineyard naturally allows sufficient sunlight to penetrate bunch zone for even ripening. This wine features a full, rich palate characterized by aromas of stone fruit, orange blossom, and white apple Vivino: 3.8/5 | Panel Rating: 8/10

UVA MIRA CHRADONNAY 2020

Elegant and fresh, the Mira is produced in a gently oaked style from select chardonnay vineyards on the Estate. A wine of intense purity with a creamy texture and enticing minerality. The first impression is one of pure and exquisite elegance. Beautifully layered with freshness and complexity of flavour with succulent white peach. Vivino: 4.1/5 | Panel Rating: 8.4/10 | Tim Atkin: 94/100



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PINOTAGE

VRIESENHOF 2008

Springbok flank and Western province legend Jan "Boland" Coetzee was a force behind the famous 1973 Pinotage of Kanonkop, going on his own in 1980 at Vriesenhof. He understands the grape, with its depth of expression and benefits from bottle maturation.

CHATEAU NAUDE "LE VIN DE FRANCOIS' 2018

Francois Naude gave up his pharmacy in Pretoria to make wines in his house in Stellenbosch. After a span at L'Avenir, he decided to link with the six best Pinotage producers from Stellenbosch, buying a single barrel from each and then blending to create "FRANCOIS". Released only by auction. Vivino: 4.8/5 | Panel Rating: 9.1/10

GRANGEHURST 2012

Medium to full body, moderate acidity, and firm tannins. The 2012 growing season in Stellenbosch may have influenced the specific profile of Grangehurst Pinotage 2012. Factors such as weather conditions, vineyard practices, and winemaking techniques all contributed to the final expression of the wine.

Vivino: 4.1/5 | Panel Rating: 8.2/10

BEYERSKI OOF "KRIEKBUI T" 2021

Their first site-specific Pinotage has been produced from 27-year-old Pinotage bush vines. The Kriekbult Pinotage expresses abundant black fruit flavours, from blackberries to cassis, with balanced oak aromas from barrel maturation. It is a wine with excellent balance, and long juicy aftertaste.
