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AREA GUIDE

1. SHOPPING



The two nearest small shopping centres are **Constantia Village** on Constantia Main Road, and the **Constantia Emporium** on Ladies Mile Road. Less than 5 minutes drive from Le Vine, both centres have anchor supermarkets and a range of smaller convenience stores, gift stores, salons, health stores and pharmacies. Constantia Village is larger and has a broader offering that includes a number of clothing and homeware stores, a tailor, banks, mobile phone stores, a home store, a post office, a camping shop and a range of restaurants and coffee shops.

The Constantia Emporium offers a new Checkers supermarket with experiential elements that include a sushi bar, a coffee bar, a chocolatier, freshly-made artisanal breads and stone-ground pizzas, and good fresh meat, fish and cheese counters.



There are two other large malls less than a 15 minute drive away, both of which have Ster Kinekor movie theatres and more extensive retail offerings. These are **Blue Route Mall** (16 Tokai Road, Tokai) and **Cavendish Square** (1 Dreyer Street, Claremont).

2. MEDICAL



PHARMACIES:

There are two pharmacies at Constantia Village. Constantia Pharmacy can be found in the main building and Clicks, a large retail pharmacy, is located in the Courtyard shopping area. There is a Clicks at Constantia Emporium too. There is also a Dischem pharmacy about an 8-minute drive away in Wynberg (open until 7pm most days) located at 222 Main Road Wynberg.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:

Should you have a medical emergency, you can call an ambulance by dialling 10177 from any phone.

HOSPITALS:

The closest private hospital is Mediclinic Constantiaberg which has a 24 hour casualty unit. It is located in Burnham Road, Plumstead (approximately an 8 minute drive away from Le Vine). You can also find a casualty unit at Kingsbury hospital in Claremont (about a 15 minute drive)

DOCTOR:

If you need to see a doctor during your stay, we can assist you to set up an appointment with our family GP, Dr Peter Sandell or any of his partners, who work at the Fairmont Family Practice at the Kingsburg hospital in Claremont. Their contact details are: +27 (021) 683 6810.

4. GYM (INCL. POOL& SQUASH COURTS)



The closest health club is Virgin Active Constantia, located at the Constantia Sports Ground, Constantia Main road. Visitors can pay per visit to use the extensive facilities at the gym which include a 25 metre indoor pool, fitness classes, strength & training equipment and squash courts. 5. GOLF



We are lucky to be in relatively close proximity to two beautiful golf estates:

- The **Steenberg Golf Club** is rated as one of the top 3 clubs in South Africa and is approx 12 minutes drive from Le Vine. (www.steenberggolfclub.co.za: Bookings 021 715 0227)

6. BEACHES

Cape Town boasts some of the most beautiful beaches in the world. From Le Vine, the two closest recommended beaches are Muizenberg and Llandudno, but there are many others to explore.



Muizenberg (approx 25 minute drive, accessible via the M3 South) The water is warmer at Muizenberg and it is the perfect place to go for a surf (there are loads of surf shops along the beachfront where you can get an instructor and rent boards and wetsuits). Muizenberg gets very busy during season, so if you prefer a slightly quieter beach where the water is still warm enough for swimming, you can drive along the coast from Muizenberg to the St James or Fishhoek beaches.

St James (approx 30 minutes drive). Beyond Muizenberg, if you continue to follow the coastline towards Simonstown, you will get to Kalk Bay. There you will find St James Beach, a smaller beach with a tidal pool. You may also want to visit the **Dalebrook Tidal pool**, which is a firm favourite with locals, for a dip.

Boulders beach (approx 45 minutes drive). Increasingly popular with tourists, Boulders beach is found even further along the same coastline as Muizenberg and St James. Here you can find small alcoves and if youre lucky, to swim with the penguins. See more under 'Kids'.





Llandudno (approx 30 minute drive, in the other direction - accessible over Constantia Nek). Llandudno's water is generally cold, but the beach one of Cape Town's most beautiful and is particularly recommended for sundowners and evening picnics. Note that parking can be tricky during peak season.

If you keep driving beyond Llandudno you will reach the most popular of Cape Town's Atlantic seaboard beaches (approx 40-45 minutes drive from Le Vine) – **Camps Bay** and **Clifton.** Although parking can be difficult and these beaches get packed during high season, they are both very beautiful. Camps Bay beach is easily accessible, just off the main road, while Clifton is accessed via some steep steps and is generally well protected from the wind.






If your preference is a long beach walk or a horse ride along the beach then we recommend a visit to **Noordhoek beach**, also known as Long Beach, which is a 30-35 minute drive away. Noordhoek is not a swimming beach.



CONSTANTIA WINE ROUTE





Your visit to Constantia would be incomplete without a visit to some of the outstanding wine farms that make the Constantia Valley what it is today. The information below is extracted from the specialist website www.constantiawineroute.com - please visit their site for more details!

THE CONSTANTIA TERROIR

The Constantia Valley lies on the southern slopes of the Table Mountain range and its vineyards climb up the east-facing slops of the Constantiaberg, where the vines benefit from cool sea breezes blowing in from False Bay. The average age of the vines in Constantia range between six and fifty years. Vineyards are planted at altitudes between 55 and 420 meters above sea level. The Wine Route properties, combined with independent Constantia farms, comprise a total planting of 421 hectares of vine for the ward. This amounts to 0,44% of the total plantings in South Africa. It terroir motivated 63,58% of white varietals lead the production in this area.

BEAU CONSTANTIA

Beau Constantia is a boutique wine farm situated at the top of Constantia Nek. The cultivated varieties include Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Shiraz and Petit Verdot. Beau Constantia is home to the well known fine dining restaurant Chefs Warehouse and is well worth a visit. www.beauconstantia.com



BUITENVER-WACHTING

Buitenverwachting, which literally means 'beyond expectation', specialises in Sauvignon Blanc, as well as some Bordeaux red varietals. Wine tastings are housed in the historic wine cellar and casual charcuterie platters with fresh baguettes are available as well as an artisan ale to cleanse your pallet. www.buitenverwachting.com



SILVERMIST

Silvermist Organic Wine Estate has planted three cultivars, namely Sauvignon Blanc, Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay. Silvermist has an African-style deli and wine bar, and is home to the world-renowned African drumming show -Drumstruck. It also offers some of the most spectacular views in the City. CONSTANTIA ROYALE

Constantia Royale is a limited production Sauvignon Blanc made from grapes grown on the 17-hectare, family-owned farm of Nova Zonnestraal. Wine tastings are offered in anunusual location: a tunnel under the M3 freeway Once inside there is no noise and just impeccable views of the Constantiaberg.

HIKES AND TRAILS

There are many beautiful places in and around Constantia for hiking / walking. For your safety, we recommend that you do not hike alone - rather stick to groups of 2-4 people if possible. Remember to take extra water, a hat, good walking shoes and a windbreaker or warm sweater (even if it is a hot day). Don't forget your cellphones (in case you get lost and need to give us a ring). GROOT CONSTANTIA

For a beautiful walk just on our doorstep - you can walk directly into Groot Constantia via the Gate on Ou Wingerd Pad and meander along the paths through the vineyards. For a more strenuous walk, head up the circular path to the very top of the vineyard and loop back down. You can also extend your walk to the bottom of the vineyard around the dam.

Duration: Half an hour to 1.5

Skill level: Easy





THE CONSTANTIA GREEN BELT

In Constantia's green belt there are no fewer than 9 interwoven trails that provide inner city walking that is easy to reach but which still gives you a feeling of being away from it all. Each of these walks takes about 30 mins to 1 hour and require very little skill. Some of the most popular walks include:

Alphen Trail: Park on Alphen Driveoff of Constantia Main Road and set off along the path next to the Diep River. There are a couple of bridge crossings where you can choose to walk on the other side. This isn't a circular route and you can also start the walk on the other end and park on Le Sueur Avenue.

The Diep River Trail: Can include the Alphen Trail or join it at Le Sueur Meadown on the bend of Brommersvlei Road, on Avenue Beauvais or Southern Cross Drive.

Silverhurst Trail: Starts just down Constantia Main Road as you pass High Constantia where you can park your car. It is a beautiful lush walk that runs along Silverhurst Estate.

The Brommersvlei walk: Almost encased by Rathfelder avenue where the road makes the famous loop around the Bel Ombre Meadow.





CONSTANTIA NEK

There are various routes starting at the Forestry road at Constantia Nek. You can either choose to veer left and take you upwards via some steep steps, or choose the more gentle winding route up the mountain. There is an option to walk into Kirstenbosch Gardens along this route.

Duration: 2-4 hours (depending on route) **Skill level:** Easy to moderate



TOKAL FOREST

This is a lovely circular route around the Tokai forest where you will find many locals in the early mornings and evenings jogging or walking their dogs. This is an oasis in the middle of Tokai which is part forest and part gorgeous open fynbos views.

Duration: 45 mins - 1 hour **Skill level:** Easy



ELEPHANT'S EYE

A little further afield, the Elephants Eye hike starts at Silvermine Dam near Noordhoek. Elephant's Eye is a large cave in the Silvermine Nature Reserve that resembles the head of these majestic creatures. A stunning hike with gorgeous views, and the option of having a swim in the dam afterwards.

Duration: 2-2.5 hours **Skill level:** Moderate



SKELETON GORGE

This hike begins in
Kirstenbosch gardens and
takes right up to Maclear's
Beacon, the highest point on
Table Mountain. This is a long
hike with ladders so you should
be fit. The ladders and rocks
are slippery when wet so
during the rainy season it is
better to do Nursery Ravine.

Duration: 2-4 hours **Skill level:** Moderate to hard



MUIZENBERG TO KALK BAY

St James Coastal Walk on the Muizenberg Mile is a gorgeous, seaside walkway winds its way along the beach and rock pools in Muizenberg. Start in Muizenberg and follow the walkway through to St James. We recommend stopping in Kalk Bay to look at the shops and for a bite to eat.

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Duration: 1.5 hours **Skill level:** Easy



NURSERY RAVINE

An alternative route to Skeleton Gorge, this is a steep, mostly shaded climb from Kirstenbosch Gardens up to Table Mountain. The top of the Ravine involves some rough boulder hopping on large steps. There is also a ladder at the top.

Duration: 2-3 hours **Skill level:** Moderate



MARKETS



The Cape is well known for its outstanding markets, and locals gather regularly to enjoy good food, wine and locally made goods. Pop-up markets are also common in our area, and if you'd like to find out what's happening during your visit, you can check online at www.capemarkets.co.za.

Our personal favourite foodie market is **ORANJEZICHT CITY FARM MARKET**, a farmer's style market held every Saturday and Sunday
(and Wednesday nights through the summer) at the historic Granger
Bay site of the V&A Waterfront. The food and the vibe are amazing &
we highly recommend popping past for a casual meal.

FINE DINING

In Constantia you are spoilt for choice with several fine dining options that rate amongst the top in Cape Town, in South Africa and in the world! In 2023, La Colombe was rated the best restaurant in South Africa in the Eat Out Awards. Both La Colombe and Chefs Warehouse received 3 star ratings (of only seven 3 star restaurants in the country), while Foxcroft and beyond received 2 star ratings. All of these restaurants are located within a 2 to 10-minute drive from Le Vine Constantia and require advance bookings.
