For example, rare sightings of free roaming wild dogs, spotted hyaena and cheetah have been reported on a few occasions in the area and on our farm, as well as vultures and redbilled oxpeckers which, were re-introduced a few years ago. All of these are monitored by wildlife interest groups and every sighting is important.

Your observations can better help to manage our environment. If possible, try to pinpoint the location of what you saw on the map.
