



HATARI LODGE

ARUSHA NATIONAL PARK






LOCATION | SETTING

Set in the vast & beautiful Arusha National Park, Hatari is nestled on the edge of a pristine woodland overlooking a glade called 'Momella meadow' with views of Mt. Kilimanjaro & Mt. Meru.

Two of the natural world's most famous sisters, Mount Kilimanjaro & Mount Meru, are separated by only 348 kilometers, and can be enjoyed slope-to-slope within an 1.5 hour drive

A legendary handmade bush lodge, once the setting for the 1962 Hollywood film, Hatari!

Wild & romantic, the original farm buildings have been updated to house a central living & dining room, where guests gather round the warmth of the large stone fireplace or watch over the glade from the open deck.



ACCESS | ACCOMMODATION

International & scheduled flights -

Kilimanjaro International Airport & Arusha Airport - Both less than an hour from/to Hatari Lodge.

No need to go through Arusha to connect to next safari destination as -

West Kilimanjaro Airstrip is approx. 1 hour away or take a stunning drive around Mt. Meru through plantations of coffee, making your way to the Northern Circuit Safari Highway.

Spacious ensuite rooms with cosy fireplaces and large verandas. Wake up on the foothills of Mt. Meru, with views of Mt. Kilimanjaro.



Lodge/Camp Staff – Gratuities can be paid on departure and are split between all staff. The expected gratuity amount at the lodge/camp is US\$10.00 per room per day

Rangers – The expected gratuity amount for rangers is US\$10.00

Cash – Tanzanian currency is the Tanzanian shilling (TZS). US\$ are accepted throughout Tanzania.
