





Merlot is one of the most widely planted red grape varieties in the world, along with its Bordeaux stablemate, Cabernet Sauvignon. With its soft, round tannins, it is bottled as an easy-drinking varietal wine in most wine-producing countries, from South Africa and Australia to Chile, Italy and the United States. In France, it is an important component of classic Bordeaux blends. Merlot-based Bordeaux cuvées are often fleshy, approachable and higher in alcohol than their Cabernet Sauvignon-led counterparts. Merlot's smooth tannins can be attributed to the grapes' thin skins. Primary flavour characteristics include raspberry, strawberry, black cherry and plum, as well as mocha, vanilla and cloves.





It ripens mid-season and can bring very deep colour, ample tannin, and a particular plum-like flavour component which adds complexity to claret blends.

PAUL WALLACE BLACK DOG

Much like the dog the wine is dark in colour, well-muscled, intense and full of character. The Black Dog Malbec presents with an intriguing somewhat exotic nose, conjuring up hints of blue berries, black berries, bramble, rhubarb and dark chocolate. The entry onto the palate is a satisfying fruit-filled mouthful of dark fruits linked by a thread of white pepper and nutmeg and held together with amiable tannins.

Fortified Wine

Stellenbosch Region

Before modern refrigeration, fortified wine was produced in an attempt to prevent wine spoilage by increasing its alcohol content. Distilled spirits like brandy are added at varying times during the fermentation process, which boosts the alcohol content and alters the flavor of the final product. If the spirits are added before the fermentation process is complete, the fortified wine acquires a sweeter taste. Conversely, the wine tends to be more dry if the spirits are added later. Both sweet and dry varieties are often served as aperitifs or digestifs before or after meals to help stimulate appetite and digestion.

Poravin Selection

The Coravin Wine Preservation System allows users to pour wine from a bottle without removing the cork. This is accomplished by inserting a thin, hollow needle through the cork, allowing wine to be poured out while argon gas is pumped into the bottle, thus preventing oxidation. The idea is that this preserves the wine remaining in the bottle, allowing it to be enjoyed over a longer period without the wine spoiling due to exposure to oxygen. This system is particularly useful for wine enthusiasts who wish to sample different wines without committing to finishing an entire bottle in one sitting, as well as for preserving high-quality or rare wines.
