#### BIKING\*


There are some wonderful routes that make it easy to explore the surrounding area on bike. We can arrange bike rental with a local company, just let us know and we can book these for you.

#### HIKING

Enjoy a hike through the hills, valleys and vineyards surrounding the hotel, as well as in local nature reserves. The Mont Rochelle Nature Reserve on the opposite side of the valley offers superb views of the wine valley and on a clear day you can even see Table Mountain and the ocean! The walks vary in length from 3 to 8 hours and are of moderate intensity. You will need to acquire a 1 day permit that costs R50 per person and a map that costs R20. You are welcome to take walks through our farm and our only request is that you stay on the walkways, to preserve the fragile vines that produce our splendid wines.



#### FRANSCHHOEK MOTOR MUSEUM


