Having been born on the western edge of the Okavango Delta, the safari bug bit me at an early age. I have always been passionate about the bush and the animals we are privileged to view on our doorstep in Botswana. Xigera Safari Lodge was one of the very first lodges built many decades ago, and I have had the pleasure of a front-row seat to watch it transform over the years.

Xigera has always been known as a "wet" camp. However, in the last four to five years, some changes occurred in the landscape, both from a flora and a geological perspective. The new Xigera has been a rebirth not only from an animal sightings perspective but the lodge itself, and the incredible food and service we proudly deliver sets us apart from everyone else.





This is Xigera (pronounced 'kee-jera'), named for the Pied Kingfisher that makes its home amid the watery channels of Botswana's Moremi Game Reserve. Every aspect is handcrafted to beguile our guests' senses and stir their souls – from the evocative interiors to one-of-a-kind encounters.

But Xigera is equally a line in the sand—a raising of the bar—a bold statement in the realm of luxury safaris in Botswana, and an Okavango Delta safari experience like no other.



AFRICAN LUXURY, REDEFINED

Xigera Safari Lodge is deeply rooted in the Okavango Delta, a breathtaking landscape of seasonal floodplains and riverine forests, tawny grasslands and verdant papyrus wetlands. Drawing inspiration from its ancient setting, Xigera rests effortlessly within the wilderness of this World Heritage Site.

All but hidden amid a canopy of magnificent indigenous trees, Xigera Safari Lodge offers 12 spacious suites, each individually designed. For multi-generational guests, there is the impressive two-bedroom Family Suite.

All the guest suites are air-conditioned and include a separate lounge, bedroom and dressing room area. Positioned to offer complete privacy and uninterrupted views, each has its own wooden deck with an outdoor gazebo for daytime lounging.





A WILDERNESS WONDERLAND

OUR GUESTS CAN EXPECT INCREDIBLE WILDLIFE SIGHTINGS FROM THE MOMENT THEY ARRIVE AT THE CAMP.

Our beautiful leopards and lions are a regular sight in and around the lodge. As the seasons change, so too does the wildlife, with the floods bringing even more giraffes, elephants, wild dogs and buffalo.

Situated on the western fringes of the Moremi Game Reserve, the surrounding islands and grassland promise some of the best wildlife viewing opportunities Botswana has to offer. Elephants are arguably the stars of the show.

Northern Botswana is home to the world's largest population of Loxodonta Africana, and at last count, more than 130,000 wild elephants still roamed free here.

On mokoro and motorboat excursions, look out for the area's smaller inhabitants, like the tiny, mottled frogs that cling to delicate papyrus reeds. Stealthy crocodiles and large pods of hippos shy away from attention in the deeper channels and lagoons. The lush grasslands also support large herds of antelope, including kudu, wildebeest and the semi-aquatic red lechwe. Packs of endangered African wild dogs are found here, too, as are the ever-resourceful spotted hyena.

XIGERA'S EXCEPTIONAL LOCATION DELIVERS SOME OF THE BEST BIRDING BOTSWANA HAS TO OFFER.

From the coppery-tailed coucal to the western-banded snake eagle, wattled crane to lesser jacana, there are 500 species recorded in the Okavango Delta.



TOUCHING THE EARTH LIGHTLY

We are committed to ensuring that this UNESCO World Heritage Site and the unique wildlife it is home to survive and thrive – this is a priority in every aspect of lodge operations.

Xigera relies mainly on solar energy supplied by a state-of-the-art Tesla system, while hot water is provided via thermodynamic geysers. The reduction of single-use plastics and an on-site composter minimises waste. All water used in the lodge is purified using reverse osmosis and then re-mineralised, ensuring guests can safely drink the tap water throughout the lodge.

The lodge works closely with Botswana's Department of Wildlife and National Parks to monitor the area's fauna and flora and has partnered with Wild Entrust Africa, a local NPO that focuses on conservation through applied science, education and sustainable development.








XIGERA AND WILD ENTRUST AFRICA PARTNERSHIP

AT RED CARNATION HOTELS, WE BELIEVE WE HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO OUR LOCAL COMMUNITIES, AND WE STRIVE TO POSITIVELY IMPACT THE COMMUNITIES THAT OUR HOTELS INHABIT.

For this reason, we have partnered with **Wild Entrust Africa**, a Botswana-registered not-for-profit organisation that focuses on the conservation and management of wildlife and wildlife habitats through applied science, education, and sustainable development.







ELEPHANT HAVENS EXPERIENCE

AS BOTSWANA'S ONLY ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE,

Elephant Havens is a not-for-profit organisation which promotes habitat protection, community outreach and the rescue and hand-rearing of young elephant orphans. This orphanage rescues orphaned and abandoned baby elephants, with the goal of eventually releasing them back into the wild alongside the other elephants. Helicopter Horizons' aim is to support Elephant Havens in a sustainable, non-evasive and ethical manner by using tourism as a platform to educate travellers on the importance of putting every animal's protection first.

A visit to Elephant Havens with Helicopter Horizons includes return helicopter transfers, interaction with orphaned elephants, guided by informed and knowledgeable handlers, and a donation to the organisation.

COMMUNITY

COMMUNITY UPLIFTMENT, LOCAL EMPLOYMENT, SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING

HABU VILLAGE EXCURSION

The Habu Village Excursion provides insight into a village based 70km from Xigera in the Okavango Delta, showcasing how we are driving positive, sustainable change with the help of trusted charities, including Wild Entrust.

The Habu community is one of the closest villages to Xigera Safari Lodge, situated on the Delta's westernmost distributary, the Thaoge River. Wild Entrust has been successfully working with the community since 2014, running an integrated community development and conservation programme that aims to mitigate human-wildlife conflict and reduce bushmeat hunting in the area.


XIGERA ART TOUR

The Xigera Art Tour showcases the breadth of creativity from the 80 commissioned artists who created pieces specifically for Xigera.

You'll also learn more about our passion for sustainability, where a number of pieces were created with a sustainability focus; these include Adam Birch's work (crafted from wood from fallen trees around Xigera) and the Further In & Further Out piece (made entirely from beer bottle caps).





THE POLOKONG CENTRE

Polokong Centre for Elderly Care, a community project founded in 2010 in Maun, Botswana, aims to restore dignity to human life. The centre provides cooked meals, food baskets, clothing, and assistance with bathing for the elderly.

They also offer emotional and spiritual support, conduct home visits, and help with laundry and house cleaning. The centre relies on volunteers to carry out these essential services. Polokong's major needs include food, clothing, blankets, shelter, house cleaning, help with cooking, and volunteers.

Inspired by the humanitarian aid provided by Polokong, the Xigera team has been actively involved in various volunteer activities and has contributed food baskets, primarily consisting of vegetables, to support the elderly.

VILLAGE LIGHTS

At Xigera, we believe in the power of education and the importance of providing resources to those who need them most. This belief drove our collaboration with Coaching Conservation, part of Wild Entrust Africa, to support the Village Lights project.

The aim of the Village Lights project was to address domestic energy insecurity by providing solar lights and supporting conservation-related learning material for primary school children to study at night. Few homes in Habu have electricity for light to enable children to read after dark.

A simple contribution of a solar-powered reading light in the home and relevant reading materials have a farreaching impact in improving learning for Habu's 350+ primary school students.

In this project, 150 silicon solar lights were provided to students as well as supplementary learning materials curated for primary students by Coaching Conservation, a part of Wild Entrust Africa. Guests were also able to purchase lanterns in the Xigera Shop, where a donation was made to the trust.





COACHING CONSERVATION PROGRAMME

To engage primary school children in understanding the value of conservation through play and sport for their future well-being, Wild Entrust facilitated a Coaching Conservation programme at the Habu primary school.

Coaching Conservation's unique "learning from wildlife" curricula was entirely delivered through games and activities rather than classroom learning and proved to be a very effective way of exploring critical conservation issues with students.

All of the programmes were based on play and capitalised on the inherent value of sport. In 2021, an abridged, single-day version of the programme took place, called a BushRAP (Rapid Awareness Programme). The Animal RAP was Coaching Conservation's activity-based programme designed to focus students on an animal mentor that they had a lot to learn from in terms of respecting themselves, others, and the environment.

The BushRAP combined this animal mentor activity with an exciting day in a wildlife area for students to feel the full benefit of a personal experience with wildlife in a positive environment.

In 2021, Coaching Conservation partnered with Xigera Safari Lodge to take the Habu village grade six class on this BushRAP as a community outreach programme. It was hoped that in the future, the full programme would be able to be delivered to students.

COLLABORATION

XIGERA'S PARTNERSHIP WITH LOCAL FARMERS

AT XIGERA, WE WORK VERY CLOSELY WITH LOCAL FARMERS AND SUPPLIERS TO BE AS SUSTAINABLE AS POSSIBLE.

Most of our products are organically farmed, including our beef, lamb, and eggs, with 90% of our food sourced from Maun, which is 60 miles away from the lodge.

We work with a small family who run their own egg farm. Slebtech Farms employs just a few people from the community and supplies us with eggs for our staff canteen. We support them through our business, and in turn their business is thriving.

We also work with Bellfrog Farms, which has a hydroponic farm in Maun. They supply us with tomatoes, herbs, lettuce, spring onions, and more. Vertical farming is suited to the harsh conditions of the outer delta areas, as water is scarce and soil quality is not great.



Elliewood Farms supplies our lamb; Chef Ziyaad personally selects our sheep and helps prepare them for consumption. We handle the lambs in our kitchen and do in-house butchery. They also supply us with certain seasonal vegetables and eggs for our guest kitchen. It is a sustainable farm that uses a full-circle philosophy.

Our beef is single-source, grass-fed and hormone-free. We use only the highest grade; we take the entire carcass, then butcher and dry age in-house.

We support a small farm called Grow Wild Organics, which supplies us with certain fresh produce and fresh quail eggs.

We also support a local cooperative comprised of women who own small stalls that supply local traditional ingredients.

We buy amazing free-range chicken from a small local farmer; they are on a natural diet and are hormone and antibiotic-free.

We support a local seafood supplier who sources the freshest seafood from our nearest coastline in Namibia weekly. We only use sustainable and seasonal catches on our menus.



SITUATED ON THE WESTERN EDGE OF THE MOREMI GAME RESERVE IN BOTSWANA'S OKAVANGO DELTA

Spanning 15 000-square kilometres, the Okavango Delta is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Arrive by chartered plane from Maun (25-minute flight) and short vehicle/boat transfer to the lodge.

Suspended on stilts and connected by elevated walkways, the lodge rests effortlessly across two islands, set beneath a canopy of ancient forests to offer remarkable views of the floodplains.
