### SOUTH AFRICAN RED WINES

- Allesverloren Tinta Barocca 2020** 14% Alc /Vol **R435**  
 Riebeeck-West - WO Swartland (Est. 1704)  
 Leading wine from rare grape in SA. Full-bodied, fruity, plum and fynbos. Lightly oaked.
- Alto Estate Rouge 2021** 14% Alc /Vol **R360**  
 Paradyskloof - WO Stellenbosch (Est. 1906)  
 Fantastic old favourite – blend of Shiraz and Bordeaux. Ripe fruitcake nose. Really!
- Backsberg Merlot 2022** 14% Alc /Vol **R360**  
 Paarl – WO Coastal (Est. 1916)  
 Belies its lowly rating. A lovely, lightly-oaked Merlot. This is also a kosher wine.
- Hamilton-Russell Pinot Noir 2023** 13.5% Alc /Vol **R1040**  
 Hermanus – WO Hemel-en-Aarde (Est. 1975)  
 Pioneering South African Pinot Noir. Classic, bright and light. A king amongst wines.
- Kanonkop Pinotage 2022** 14.5% Alc./Vol **R910**  
 Stellenbosch – WO Simonsberg-Stellenbosch (Est. 1910)  
 Mocha eclipses spicy red fruity aromas. Juicy dark plum flavours. A Cape benchmark!
- \*Laborie Merlot 2023** 14% Alc /Vol **R65/glass** **R250**  
 Paarl – WO Paarl (Est. 1691)  
 Creamy, smooth, red berries – combine the curries or the pastas with this one!
- \*Springfield Cabernet Sauvignon 2021** 13.5% Alc/Vol **R150/glass** **R595**  
 Breede River Valley – WO Robertson (Est. 1995)  
 Currants, mulberry and a hint of woodsmoke – organic – wonderful with a beef dish.
- Thierry and Guy Fat Bastard Shiraz 2022** 14% Alc /Vol **R420**  
 Breede River Valley – WO Robertson (Est. 1995)  
 Robust, but juicy. Originated in France, but produced in SA by Robertson. A Rissington favourite!
- \*Zandvliet Shiraz 2022** 14% Alc./Vol **R120/glass** **R465**  
 Ashton – WO Robertson (Est. 1867)  
 Sweet-spicy oaky Shiraz, more nuts and spices than fruit - absolutely world-class.

### BLANCS DE NOIR & ROSÉS

- \*Boschendal Blanc de Noir 2023** 13.5% Alc /Vol **R65/glass** **R245**  
 Franschhoek – WO Simonsberg (Est. 1685)  
 Delicious red-fruited lunchtime off-dry with a salad or a trout dish.
- \*Goats Do Roam Rosé 2023** 13.5% Alc /Vol **R65/glass** **R260**  
 Paarl – WO Coastal (Est. 1998)  
 Shiraz-led Rhone, light floral notes, cherry and herb. Dry finish.

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### SOUTH AFRICAN WHITE WINES

**\*Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc 2024** 13.5% Alc /Vol **R65/glass R245**

Constantia - WO Constantia (Est. 1796)

Ever-popular and reliable. Sauvignon Blanc with some Chenin, Semillon and Viognier.

**\*Groote Post Sauvignon Blanc 2024** 13.5% Alc /Vol **R95/glass R360**

Darling – WO Darling (Est. 1999)

4-star well-balanced wine with a supple and lively finish. A perfect chilled wine.

**Hartenberg Riesling 2022** 14% Alc/Vol **R400**

Stellenbosch – WO Stellenbosch (Est. 1978)

Elegantly dry, very delicate floral scents, with a spicy richness.

**Haute-Cabrière Chardonnay Pinot Noir 2024** 12% Alc /Vol **R360**

Franschhoek – WO Franschhoek (Est. 1982)

Delicious, dry, light wine - a “still champagne” - wonderful light meal or salad wine.

**Ken Forrester Chenin Blanc Reserve 2024** 13.5% Alc /Vol **R410**

Helderberg – WO Stellenbosch (Est. 1994)

Scrumptious, powerful and impressive. Chenins are back on the map!

**\*La Motte Chardonnay 2023** 12.5% Alc /Vol **R110/glass R435**

Franschhoek – WO Franschhoek (Est. 1969)

Fresh and refreshing. Lemon and lime fruit, cashew nut in the background.

**\*Legacy Johannisberger N/V** 11.5% Alc /Vol **R40/glass R145**

Wellington - WO Western Cape (Est. 1693)

By Bellingham. Popular semi-sweet - soft, easy with faint tints of citrus and honey.

**Springfield Life/Stone Sauvignon Blanc 2024** 12.5% Alc/Vol **R425**

Breede River Valley – WO Robertson (Est. 1995)

Eked from 75 % Quartz rock – stunning and individual with great depth.

### CHAMPAGNE–STYLE CAP CLASSIQUES & SPARKLING

**Pierre Jourdan Brut N/V** 12% Alc /Vol **R510**

Franschhoek – WO Franschhoek (Est. 1982)

100% Pinot Noir, rich strawberry and cherry flavours. Pink Méthode Cap Classique.

**Pongrácz Brut Desiderius N/V** 12% Alc /Vol **R620**

Devon Valley – WO Western Cape

Soft, fresh and delicate – a Méthode Cap Classique popular with the locals.

**J.C. Le Roux Le Domaine N/V** 7.5% Alc /Vol **R260**

Stellenbosch – WO Western Cape (Est. 1983)

Low alcohol, sweet, sparkling wine, carbonated with light bubbles.
